### **Bus na gCos | Walking Bus**

Tá sé i gceist againn Bus na gCos a dhéanamh gach Aoine as seo amach. Iarrtar ort éadaí oiriúnacha a chaitheamh agus an carr a fhágáil sa bhaile más féidir. Fiú mura siúlann tú ach cuid den bhealach, chabhróidh sé leis an ardú feasachta. Ar an ábhar céanna, bí cinnte de le do thoil go bhfuil cóta ag do pháiste gach lá. Tá páistí áirithe ag léimt as carranna ar maidineacha breátha agus ní bhíonn aon chóta acu nuair a thagann athrú ar an aimsir níos déanaí sa lá!

### **Rince Gaelach | Irish Dancing**

Beidh na Ranganna ó R3 go R6 ag tosú le Rince Gaelach ar scoil gach Déardaoin le linn an lae. Ní bheidh aon chostas air seo agus níl aon ghá éadaí spóirt a chaitheamh mura bhfuil siad á gcaitheamh ar an Déardaoin ar aon nós. Is cuid den churaclam ceoil agus den churaclam corpoideachais é seo agus cabhraíonn sé linn blaiseadh de chultúr iomlán na Gaeilge a thabhairt do na páistí. Táthar ag súil leis go leanfaidh an rince aghaidh leis na bunranganna i ndiaidh na Nollag.

***The Masterson Academy of Irish Dance*** was established in 2015 by World Championship dancer Lauren Masterson O.D.C.R.N. We are a fully inclusive school where students of all capabilities, levels and ages are catered for. Come to dance for fun and fitness or come to dance to compete, the choice is totally yours. Our school values team-work and so team dancing is included in all lessons. Tosóidh téarma an Bhoird ar an 1 Mí na Nollag agus mairfidh sé 4 bliana. Táimid an-bhuíoch de gach duine a tháinig chun an chruinnithe.

There is an important note below about the role of the Parent Nominnes and it's crucial that all parents in the school understand the role of these nominees to teh Board of Management, The term of the new Board will begin on 1 December and will last 4 years.. We are very grateful to all who attended the meeting.

**Important Note:** Board members are not delegates of their electorates. They have no obligation to either report back to their electors or to take instruction from them on how to vote at board meetings. Such reporting may be a breach of confidentiality requirements. It is a matter for each Board to decide what may be reported and by whom and, in this respect, it is essential that personnel, financial and personal matters are dealt with in line with relevant confidentiality requirements. Decisions arrived at by consensus or by vote are decisions of the Board. Individual members of the Board are obliged to keep the matters discussed at meetings confidential, unless otherwise agreed by the Board and where so agreed, members of the Board must not publicly criticise or make any negative public comment about Board decisions, irrespective of their own personal views on the matter. Section 9.3 provides for the Board to put in place an agreed report to support good communications to parents, staff and the school community. The agreed report shall not include details of any issues which must remain confidential to Board members.

There will be information going on the website about the new Board when the nomination process is complete. We are very grateful to all the memebrs of the Board 2015-2019. This is a voluntary role and the member sof the Board are very generous with their time and their expertise. The Board is responsible for the running of the school and there are regularly discussions to be had and decisions to be made to ensure that the children of Scoil Oilibhéir get the best experience of their primary school years. This Board did huge work to clarify the visiona nd mission of the school and this work provides great guidance for us in to the future as we try to stay true to our school vision, that is;

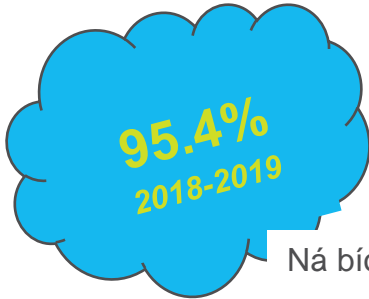

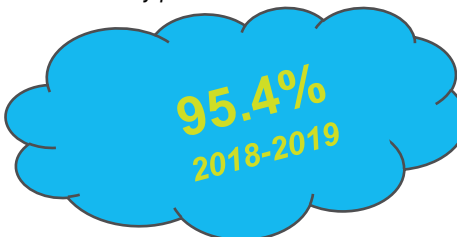

## Every School Day Count:

- *Establish a good routine in the mornings and evenings so your child is prepared for the school day ahead.*
- *Make sure your child goes to school regularly and follows the school rules.*
- *Ensure your child arrives at school on time – not late.*
- *Arrange dental and medical appointments outside school hours when possible.*
- *Always inform the school if your child is absent due to illness – this should be followed up with a written note when your child returns to school.*
- *Take truancy seriously – if your child is not attending school as you expect they may be putting themselves at risk – Who are they with? What are they doing?*
- *Take family holidays outside term time.*
- *Talk to your child about school and take an interest in their school work (including homework).*
- *Attend parent evenings and school events.*
- *Praise and reward your child's achievements at school.*
- *Always support school staff in their efforts to control difficult or challenging behaviour.*
- *Discuss any problems or difficulties with the school – staff are there to help and will be supportive.*
