The Board of Management:

The present Board's term will conclude next October. It comprises eight members:

- (i) Two direct nominees of the Patron.
- (ii) Two parents elected from parents of children who are enrolled and have commenced attendance at the school (one being a mother, the other a father, elected by the general body of parents of children who are enrolled and have commenced attendance at the school).
- (iii) The Principal teacher of the school.
- (iv) One other serving teacher on the staff of the school, elected by vote of the teaching staff which includes the Principal teacher.
- (v) Two extra members proposed by those nominees above

All of the Board's business is conducted through the medium of Irish. The Board meets every 4-6 weeks during the school year with occasional sub-committee meetings also. Most Board meetings are from 19:30 – 21:30. Board members are not delegates of their electorates and the Board acts as a Corporate Entity. Please think about putting yourself forward, it is an important role involving, amongst other things;

- Ensuring that the school is run safely and effectively,
- Ensuring that the finances are in order,
- Developing policies that protect and promote the school's ethos, vision and values,
- Supporting the provision of an education that nurtures and enriches every child, through the medium of Irish, to achieve their potential.

Do na páistí i Rang a Dó, Rang a Ceathair agus Rang a Sé, éilíonn an ROS go ndéantar na torthaí seo a thuairisciú do na tuistí agus cé nach gá dúinn, i Scoil Oilibhéir, le fada an lá anois, taímíd ag tuairisciú na dtorthaí seo do gach rang. Rinneadh é seo tríd an gCárta Tuairisce Bliantúil ach i mbliana beidh na torthaí seo ag dul abhaile sna tuairisci tríd *Aladdin Connect* agus tá sé tábhachtach go bhfuil na sonraí cearta againn dó seo.

Trialacha Nua in 2019

Ar an-chuid bealaí, tá na trialacha caighdeánaithe an-simplí ach bíonn deacrachtaí ag tuismitheoirí uaireanta na torthaí a thuiscint. In Scoil Oilibhéir, úsáidimid na Trialacha Dhroim Conrach. Déantar iad seo a dhearadh san Fhoras Taighde ar Oideachas agus tagann treoracha dochta do na múinteoirí faoina gceartú. I mbliana, tá trialacha nua, thusas-chun-dáta ón Foras Taighde ar Oideachas a ndearnadh caighdeánú orthu in 2018 agus a léiríonn na hathruithe is déanaí sa ghnóthachtáil náisiúnta sa mhata agus sa Bhéarla.

Cad ba chúis le hathfhorbairt na dtrialacha?

- Thug an taighde le fios go n-eíríonn trialacha níos éasca thar am agus na páistí ag dul i dtraithí orthu
- Tá feabhas ar na leibhéal ghnóthachtála go náisiúnta a chiallaigh go raibh na torthaí sna scoileanna agus go náisiúnta an-chlaonta le déanaí, i gcomparáid le noirm na dtrialacha

Cad is ciall leis seo do do pháiste?

- Mar go bhfuilimid ag baint úsáide as na trialacha nua i mbliana, táthar ag súil go mbeidh na torthaí níos cruinne i gcomparáid leis na noirm nua
- **Do pháistí áirithe, d'fhéadfadh go gciallóidh sé seo go dtiocfaidh titim nó ardú ar a dtoradh** (i gcomparáid le blianta eile) ní cús bhuartha é seo.
- Tá sé tábhachtach go gcuimhníonn tú **nach féidir toradh na bliana seo a chur i gcomparáid le toradh na bliana seo caite.** Is trialacha nua iad seo, le noirm nua. Is féidir féachaint ar an litir seo ón bhForas Taighde ar Oideachas chun tuilleadh eolais a fháil <http://www.erc.ie/wp-content/uploads/2019/05/Letter-for-parents-GAEILGE.pdf>
- Smaoinigh freisin le do thoil (mar a deir an Chomhairle Náisiúnta um Churaclam agus um Mheasúnú (CNCM) **nach trialacha éirime iad seo.** Is bealach amháin iad seo chun laigí agus láidreachtaí a aithint le go dtabharfaí treoir do thuismitheoirí. Níl sna trialacha seo ach ceann amháin de na bealaí ar fad atá in úsáid chun súil a choimeád ar dhul chun cinn do pháiste.


Gnásanna don Triail

Caithfidh múinteoirí cloí le treoracha soiléire – ní ullmhaíonn múinteoirí na páistí don triail agus ní mhúineann siad leis an triail ar intinn acu. Ní roinntear leabhrán na trialach le páistí nó tuismitheoirí nuair atá sé ceartaithe agus coimeádtar sa scoil é go ceann bliana i ndiaidh na trialach. Déantar na tortaí a stóráil go dtí go bhfuil an páiste 26 bliana d'aois.

Na Tortaí a Thuiscint STen agus Scóir Chaighdeánacha

Tá éagsúlacht idir triail caighdeánaithe agus triail thraidiúnta sa bhealach go mbaineann triail chaighdeánaithe úsáid as dhá chóras scórála, STen agus Scór Caighdeánach. I Scoil Oilibhéir, úsáidimid STen do gach rang ach amháin Rang a hAon, úsáidimid Scór Caighdeánach i Rang a hAon agus táthar ag súil leis go leanfar leis an nós seo amach anseo suas tríd an scoil

- Tá scór STen 5 nó 6 meánach agus faigheann timpeall ar 1/3 de na páistí in Éirinn an scór seo
- Tá 7 meánach ard agus faigheann timpeall ar 1/6 an scór seo
- Tá 8-10 i bhfad os cion an mheán agus faigheann timpeall ar 1/6 an scór seo
- Faigheann 1/6 de pháistí 4, meánach íseal
- Faigheann 1/6 1-3, atá faoin meán



Páistí agus a dTorthaí Trialach

Beidh na tuairisci ag dul abhaile ar ball tríd Aladdin Connect. Is fútsa atá sé, mar thuismitheoir, smaoineamh ar mhaith leat na tortaí a phlé le do pháiste. **Molaimid go láidir nach ndéanann tú na tortaí a phlé le do pháiste ach ar bhealach an-ghinearálta.** Bheadh, “Ba cheart go mbeifeá an-bhródúil as na tortaí agus asat féin” nó “Bhain tú tairbhe as an obair ar fad” i bhfad níos oriúnaí ná an iomarca anailíse. Bíonn páistí buartha mar gheall ar dhul suas nó síos agus ní haon chabhair é.

I mbliana ach go háirithe leis na noirm nua, an-seans go mbeidh athrú suntasach ar na tortaí (suas agus síos) agus d'fhéadfadh sé lagmhisneach a chur ar pháistí nach dtuigeann an córas scórála. Caithfidh tusa mar thuismitheoir cinneadh a dhéanamh faoin méid eolais atá le roinnt le do pháiste.

Níor cheart na tortaí seo a roinnt le haon duine eile, go háirithe le páistí sa rang céanna leo. Ní ábhar cainte iad na tortaí seo, go háirithe sna hardranganna, áit a gcruthaíonn siad an-chuid imní agus struis. Standardised Tests and Results

During May, we did standardised tests with all pupils from 1st to 6th Classes in English Reading, Gaeilge and Numeracy.

*For 2nd, 4th and 6th Class pupils, the DES requires that results **must be reported** to parents. Although it is not a requirement, Scoil Oilibhéir has for a long time now reported the results of these tests to every class. This was done through the Annual End-of-Year Report Card, but this year we will use Aladdin Connect to report Standardised Test results to parents and it is very important that we have the correct details for this.*

New Tests in 2019

Standardised tests are straightforward in many ways but interpreting them can cause confusion for parents. In Scoil Oilibhéir, we use the Drumcondra Tests. These are designed in the Educational Research Centre and are accompanied by strict instructions for correction for the teachers.

This year, there are new, up-to-date tests from the ERC, which were standardised in 2018 and reflect recent changes in performance on English and Maths nationally.

Why were the tests redeveloped?

- The tests were redeveloped as research suggested that tests generally get easier over time, as familiarity with content increases.
- There have also been national improvements in achievement levels, which have meant that results in schools and nationally, have been heavily skewed in recent years, compared with test norms.

What does that mean for your child?

As this year we will be testing using the new tests (standardised in 2018), we would expect that the results will be more in line with test norms.

For some children this may mean their result in their standardised test (compared with previous years) may be significantly lower, or indeed significantly higher. This should not be a cause for alarm for parents.

It is important to remember that you cannot compare this year's result to last year's result. These are NEW tests, with NEW standardised norms. Please see the linked letter from the ERC, which explains in further detail the changes.

Please remember that as the National Council for Curriculum and Assessment (NCCA) states, Standardised Tests are NOT intelligence tests and their main purpose is to help a teacher identify strengths and weaknesses in individual pupils and to offer some guidance to parents. Standardised tests are only one of a number of ways that we monitor and measure a child's progress.

They are not an "end of year" test. Particularly in Maths, tests can contain questions which might be more suitable to a lower or a higher class level.

Procedures for Testing

Teachers must adhere to clear directions. Teachers do not prepare children for the test – they do not ‘teach with the test in mind’.

The Corrected Test Booklet is not shared with children or parents and is kept securely on file for 12 months. Test results are then recorded until a child is 26 years of age.

Understanding results – STens & Standard Scores

A standardised test differs from traditional tests. Standardised tests use two scoring systems.


In Scoil Oilibhéir we use a STen for every class except Rang a hAon. We use a standard score for Rang a hAon and we expect to continue this practice up through the school in the future.

- A STen score of 5 or 6 is regarded as average and it should be achieved by about one-third of children in Ireland
- A 7 is a high average, achieved by about one-sixth of pupils
- An 8-10 is well above average and also achieved by about one-sixth of pupils.
- One sixth of children score a low average 4

- Another one sixth score 1-3, which is rated well below average.



Children & their Test Results

The reports will be going home soon through Aladdin Connect. It is up to you, as a parent to decide if you wish to discuss the exact result with your child.

The school would **STRONGLY** advise that you only discuss results in general terms with pupils – Comments such as “You should be very proud of your results” and “Your hard work paid off” might be more appropriate than too much analysis.

Children are often worried about going up or down and this is no help.

Particularly this year with the use of the new tests, there may be a significant change in results (in either direction), it may be very disheartening to children who do not understand the scoring system.

It is up to you, as a parent, to decide how much information, if any to share with your child.

Results should not be shared with anyone else, especially those in the same class. Test results should NOT be a topic of conversation particularly in the Senior Classes, as it can cause a lot of undue pressure for children.

No matter the results, they have all worked hard and should be proud of this.

Communicating with Teachers

If you have any concerns or questions about the new tests, please do not hesitate to contact the class teacher, or myself to discuss further.

First Class

As you are aware from the piece above, we are using new Drumcondra Tests this year.

As this is the first year of these tests being available to schools, we have learned a lot in the past month about what's in the tests and the information to be taken from them. The most significant change in relation to the tests used for 1st Class in English Reading and Maths is that these tests are now screening tests, and as a result there will be no sTen score going with them. The school will have no sTen score to share with parents when we share results. The purpose of a screening test is to help us support children who might be facing challenges within English Reading and Maths.

If the results of the screening test indicate that your child is having a difficulty and requires further support in either of these areas, Múinteoir Lára or Múinteoir Colleen will be in contact with you to discuss this further. Otherwise you can assume that your child has reached the criterion (in relation to English Reading and Maths) for the class level. **The only information that is available to the class teacher is whether the criterion was reached, or not.** Reaching the criterion, or not, indicates whether a child needs extra support, or not, and as mentioned above, if your child would benefit from further supports, you will be contacted by the class teacher.
