Seachtain na Gaeilge

Mar is eol daoibh, beidh Seachtain na Gaeilge ag tosú ón 2 Mártá agus ag leanúint go dtí Lá 'le Pádraig ar an 17 Mártá. Beidh Clár Ama lán againn agus ba mhaith linn an deis a thapú béim speisialta a leagan ar an nGaeilge labhartha arís. Tá sé tábhachtach go dtuigeann gach duine gurb í an Ghaeilge teanga na scoile agus chuige seo beidh duaiseanna dóibh siúd a labhraíonn an Ghaeilge go nádúrtha eatarthu féin agus lena gcairde. Beidh Pas Obair Bhaile do na páistí a fhraigheann 3 dhearbhán ó na múinteoirí. Is feidir na dearbhán seo a fháil sa chlós, sna siúltáin, sa seomra nó in aon áit eile! Ar an taobh eile de, má tá páistí beagánín leisciúil, nó má dhéanann siad dearmad úsáid a bhaint as a gcuid Gaeilge beidh orainn an Cód Smachta a chur i bhfeidhm. 'Sí an Ghaeilge teanga na scoile agus tá an **Chumarsáid** mar cheann de na Ceithre Théama Mhóra atá sa Chód Smachta; Má dhéanann páistí dearmad ar an nGaeilge; ar an gcéad dul síos, labhróidh múinteoir leo agus cuirfear an múinteoir ranga ar an eolas. Má tharlaonn sé don dara huair, rachaidh nóta abhaile sa dialann agus má tharlaónn sé arís ansin, beidh Cártá Bán "tuillte" acu. Beidh mé ag caint leis na páistí ag an tionól ar an Máirt agus is mór againn an tacaíocht ón mbaile. Tá Gaeilge álann ag páistí Scoil Oilibhéir agus ba mhór an trua gan úsáid a bhaint aisti. Ar ndóigh, mar a luaitear sa Chód Smachta, cuirfear cumas agus rangleibhéal an pháiste san áireamh.

As you know, Seachtain na Gaeilge will be beginning on the 2 March and continue until St. Patrick's Day on 17 March. We will have a full timetable of events and we would like to take the opportunity to lay a special emphasis on spoken Irish. It is crucial that everybody understands that Irish is the language of the school and to this end we will have special prizes for Seachtain na Gaeilge for those who use their Irish naturally amongst themselves and friends. There will be a Homework Pass for the children who get 3 Gaeilge Tokens from the teachers. These tokens can be awarded in the yard, in the corridors, in the room or in any other place. On the other side, if children are a little bit lazy or if they forget to use their Irish we will have to implement the Code of Behaviour. Irish is the language of the school and **Communication** is one of the 4 big themes of our Code of Behaviour; If children forget their Irish, in the first instance, the teacher will speak to them and inform their class teacher. If it happens a second time, a note will go home and if it happens a third time, they will have "earned" a White Card. I will speak to the children at Assembly and we really appreciate the support from home on this. The children have beautiful Irish and it would be a real pity not to make use of it. Of course, as mentioned in the Code of Behaviour, the children's ability and class level will be taken into account.

Watch the Yourtube videos they like, learn how to check history, see who they interact with. Remember children can go on the internet on phones, on iPads, on computers and on computer games. The internet is a very useful tool but it has some very serious aspects to it. We all have a responsibility to protect children from these aspects. Remember also that **you** are legally responsible for anything that happens on your home's WiFi!
