Mura bhfuil an uimhir cheart ann, ní bheidh an múinteoir in ann teagmháil a dhéanamh leat agus cuirfear am amú. If the correct number isn't there the teacher will not be able to contact you and time will be wasted. Similar to the meetings in school, the conversation will last approximately 8 minutes and you are asked to adhere to that so that other parents aren't delayed. Even 2 or 3 minutes over the time can cause huge disruption to the schedules when siblings in other classes are involved. If a longer meeting is necessary, it can be arranged with the class teacher.



Sábháilteacht Idirlín | Internet Safety

Beidh na múinteoirí ag déanamh roinnt oibre ar an ábhar seo tar éis an tsosa ach tá deis iontach agaibh an tseachtaí seo chugainn comhrá a thosú sa bhaile faoi mar theaghlaigh. Go minic má bhíonn deacrachtáí ag páistí leis an tsábháilteacht idirlín nó má fheiceann siad rudaí a ghoilleann orthu, bíonn sé ar siúl ar aipeanna nach bhfuil oiriúnach do pháistí bunscoile ar an gcéad dul síos. Tá léaráid thíos a thaispeánann na riachtanaíse aoise do na haitpeanna difriúla seo agus cé nach luíonn cuid acu le ciall dúnne b'fhéidir, is léir nár cheart go mbeadh páistí bunscoile ar aon cheann acu.

Ábhar machnaimh b'fhéidir? Tá sé tábhachtach freisin go dtuigeann tuismitheoirí go bhfuil bealaí cumarsáide agus fáil ar na meáin shóisialta trí chonsóil na gcluichí ar nós Xbox srl. Is domhan iontach, suimiúil, oideachasúil, taitneamhach an t-idirlíon ach cosúil leis an bhfíorshaol, tá contúirtí ann. An fhadhb ná go mbíonn na contúirtí seo i bhfolach nó gléasta suas mar rud/dhuine éigin eile ar an idirlíon. Is fútsa atá sé i ndáiríre tú féin a chur ar an eolas faoi na rudaí seo agus impím ort é sin a dhéanamh má tá chun ligean do do pháiste dul isteach i ndomhan sin an idirlín.

The teachers will be doing some work on this after the break but you have a great opportunity next week to start a conversation about it as a family. Quite often, if children are having difficulties with internet safety or seeing things that upset them, it happens on apps that aren't suitable for primary-school children in the first place. There is a diagram below which shows the age requirements for these different apps and although some of them may not make sense to us, it is clear that primary school children should be on none of them. Some food for thought maybe? It is important that parents understand also that there are channels of communication and access to social media available through the games consoles like Xbox etc. The internet is a wonderful, interesting, educational, enjoyable world but just like the real world, there are dangers within. The problem is these dangers are hidden or dressed up as something/someone else on the internet. It is up to you really to familiarise yourself with these things and I implore you to do so if you are going to allow your child into that online world.

Google Meet

As I explained already, there are some supports we need from you, the parents, so that we can do them in a safe and secure manner. Nobody wants a child to be upset but for the sake of all the participants' safety, there is a risk your child won't be able to take part in the meeting if they are not following these **golden** rules below.*

It only takes 3 minutes and it will prevent any child being upset when they are not admitted to a MEET because teacher doesn't recognise the account name.</p>

Recording or screenshotting is totally forbidden and nothing connected to the MEET is permitted to be shared on social media – There are privacy rights at stake here around the images of the other people.</p>

Do not participate in the call yourself – they were fairly quiet for the first call but parents didn't speak on behalf of the children. We are very grateful for this and it will help the children get used to the MEET.</p>

Ensure there is a suitable place for your child for their MEET – and that no other child/adult in the house comes into the MEET by accident.</p>

The link is available on the Stream and if you don't have access to the Stream, you shouldn't have the link. Do not ask anybody else to share the Link with you.</p>

New Irish Language Youth Club setting up in Luttrellstown! Every Wednesday, 6-7pm (date can be subject to change)

Feachtas will be setting up a new club in Luttrellstown soon! [Feachtas](#) are an Irish Language youth organisation who aim to empower young people through youth leadership and language skills. We run youth clubs and organise events and trips.

A new Feachtas Youth Club will be opening soon in Luttrellstown and the club will cater for ages 10-18. Our online sessions will last an hour and when we can all meet up again, the sessions run for an hour and a half. The club will run weekly throughout the school term.

We have lots of fun online, for example, we send packages out to the young people to do art and play games. We have lots of competitions, workshops, cookery and lots more!

Depending on government guidelines as to when we can meet again, the club will be located in Luttrellstown Community Centre.

This is a fantastic opportunity for young Irish speakers to use their Irish outside of school, to make new friends, to learn new skills and to have great craic! Membership fee is €5 for the year.

The club provides a safe space and opportunities for young people to go on trips, play games and sports, develop projects, relax, have fun, learn new skills and gain certificates like Gaisce, the President's award, among many more!

The members of our youth clubs take partake in an annual trip to Scléip na hÓige at Oireachtas na Samhna, (this is a three day event organized between the Irish language youth organizations, Óras, Coláiste na bhFiann, Spleodar and Feachtas Óg-Ghluaiseacht Gaeilge. There will be over 300 young people at this event. Irish is the spoken language of the event) Members also go to the Gaeltacht for two days and many more events.





Sa phictiúr seo ceangailte, feicfidh tú go bhuil an brabhsaer ceangailte le priomhoide.scoil.oilibheir@gmail.com (an "P" dearg thusa sa chúinne) ach tá mé sa chuntas Google aocleirigh@gmail.com (an "A" sa chirocal glas níos mó). Cruthaíonn sé fadhbanna má tá an brabhsaer ceangailte le cuntas an tuismitheora nó gan a bheith ceangailte le cuntas ar bith agus tú ag iarraidh cuntas do pháiste seosamh.o.blog@gaelescoiloilibheir.ie a úsáid.

This is a very common difficulty for parents and it is causing problems for the Google Meets. Basically, there is an account linked to the browser and then there is the Google Account that's open. In the picture below, you can see that the browser is linked to priomhoide.scoil.oilibheir@gmail.com (the "P" in the red circle in the top right hand corner) but I am in the google account for aocleirigh@gmail.com (the "A" in the bigger green circle). This creates problems if the browser is linked to the parent's gmail account or to no account when you want to use your child's account joe.bloggs@gaelescoiloilibheir.ie.


The Browser and Google account should be linked to the same account as in the picture below. This obviously works better in Chrome rather than any other browser.
